It is not only teens that need their questions answered. Moms are also looking for encouragement and wisdom! Held simultaneously as [ETC.](#), Grace Chats provides a place for moms to interact with others in a similar season in life while enjoying a warm cup of tea and also glean a good dose of wisdom from a few older women willing to lead a topical discussion steeped in Biblical truth.

- ✓ **Under the Women's Ministry Covering:** Grace Chats is especially designed to enhance a Women's ministry program, coming under their supervision, budget, and scheduling. If you'd like to see Grace Chats offered with ETC. at your church, bring this information to your Women's Ministry Director or Pastor.
- ✓ **Location:** The ideal setting for Grace Chats is in a comfortable gathering room where women can both socialize and also find a seat for a short discussion time.
- ✓ **Date & Time:** Set a bi-monthly date with a 2-hour commitment, coordinating with the ETC. schedule.
- ✓ **Identify Mom Mentors:** Gather together a group of moms (who have already raised teen girls) that would be willing to attend Grace Chats as mentors. Considering hosting a 3-part Mentoring Training using the ETC. Mentoring Training Guide.
- ✓ **Invite Moms:** Invite moms of tween and teen girls to attend while their daughter participate in ETC.
- ✓ **Tea:** Provide lots of hot water and a collection of tea bags for the women to grab upon their arrival. Keep it simple!
- ✓ **Topics & Truth:** Pick a [Topics & Truth](#) free download to work through in about 10 -15 minutes, teaching the main points. Ideally, you should be covering a topic that is also being presented to the girls attending ETC.
- ✓ **Time to Chat:** After presenting the topic, open up a discussion time, allowing moms to share their questions and also offer their input. Carefully guide this time by encouraging each person to listen more than advise. Also, encourage the moms indicate whether they simply want to be heard or if they want the input of others.
- ✓ **Prayer:** Close the time in prayer with a clear reminder that "what is shared in this room, stays in this room...if it is not your story, then it isn't yours to retell either." After prayer, encourage the moms to get a second cup of tea and enjoy chatting with each other.
